- 3 **The Plan is Made**

- 5 **So how do we start**
 - Check list
 - Should be part of plan!
- 6 -
 - Get weather forecast for the day – 7 AM
 - Confirm weather forecast is within planned parameters
 - Get burn permit
 - Notify crew – Today we burn
 - Notify neighbors
 - Stage equipment if not done the day before
 - Fuel up
 - Top off water reservoirs
 - Inspect fire breaks
 - Crew meeting
- 7 **Crew meeting – on site**
 - Insure crew is complete
 - Check communications
 - Review assignments
 - Review plan
 - Take local weather readings and observations – keep crew informed
 - Review ignition strategy
 - Review holding plan
 - Review contingency plan
- 8 **Test burn**
 - Observe fire behavior
 - Consider impact of diurnal cycle
 - Make go – no go decision
 - Extend backing strategy
 - Extend ignition
 - Periodic weather obs – inform crew
 - Start mop up as fire front passes
 - Complete ignition
- 9 **Burn out**
 - Planned time
 - Complete mop up
 - Take pictures to establish latent smoke
 - Weather ob
 - Tail gate safety meeting
 - Preliminary evaluation
 - Assign complete burn out and latent smoke watch for 2 – 5 am

- 10 **Remember**
 - Must observe until dead out
 - Remember arson
